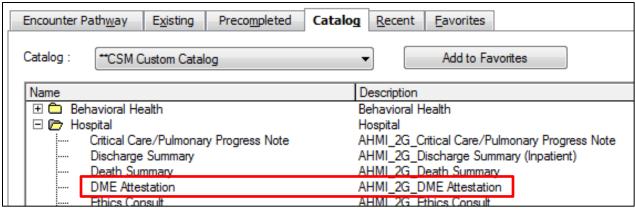
## Hospital Discharge DME Provider Documentation and Ordering

Step 1: Provide details of your face to face encounter with the patient in your documentation using POWERNOTE. Step 2: Use ePrescribe to create a <u>prescription</u> order. (The same process you use for sending a medication prescription.)

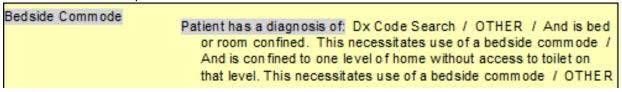
**Step 1:** Provide details of your face to face encounter with the patient in your documentation using POWERNOTE. Details that attest to the medical necessity of your order should be included.

1. In PowerNote, find "DME Attestation" in Hospital folder of CSM Custom Catalog.



- 2. Within the applicable Durable Medical Equipment\_section **enter diagnosis**.\*

  Dx Code Search will link to Diagnosis list or you can use OTHER to free text a diagnosis.
- 3. Next choose the appropriate CMS approved attestation sentence(s) to describe the medical necessity. OTHER is available if additional patient information needs to be added.



4. Sign/Submit the Power Note.

\*If there is not section applicable to the DME order you are placing, choose Free Text. Example below.

Assessment < Show Structure> <Use Free Text>

Patient has a diagnosis of severe degenerative osteoarthritis which necessitates use of a raised toilet seat to prevent falls and allow self toileting.

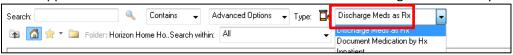
## **Step 2:** Use ePrescribe to create a <u>prescription</u> order. (The same process you use for sending a medication prescription.)

(CMS requires specific details, such as NPI# and signature, on all DME orders. These details are only available on ePrescribe prescriptions. As such you cannot use an inpatient/hospital order.)

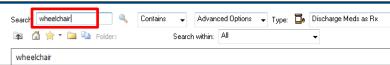
- 1. An ePrescribe prescription is accessible two ways.
  - a. It can be accessed on the Discharge Medication Reconciliation window using the "Add" button.



b. Also, from the general orders tab, you can access ePrescribe when the order type is "Discharge Meds as Rx" in upper corner of order search window. You will need to change this manually.



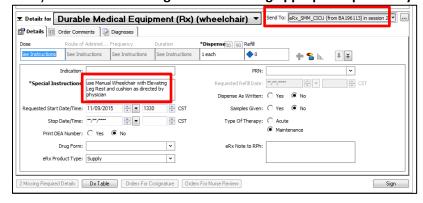
2. Search for the DME item by name.\*\*



3. The order sentence window opens. **Select an appropriate sentence**.



- 4. Close the search window.
- 5. Verify order details and sign order choosing appropriate pharmacy or designated eRx printer.
