

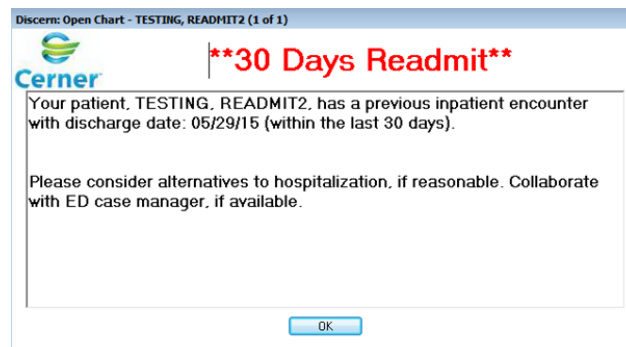

❖ **30 Days Readmission Alerts – ED and Inpatient (Effective 8/12/15)**

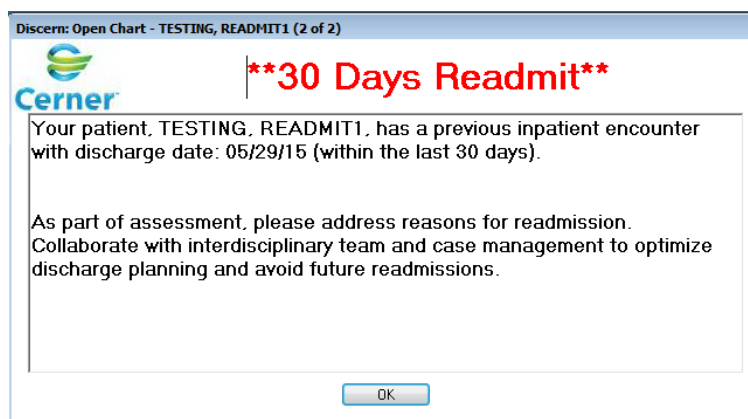
Modifications to the current ED 30 Days Readmission Alert:

- Additional language added to guide clinicians to intervene to prevent future readmissions
- Alert will continue to fire as it currently does today



New Inpatient 30 Days Readmission Alert:

- Fires for patients admitted as observation or inpatient status to inpatient location
- Fires once per user per encounter
- Fires for following positions:
 - Hospital physicians
 - Case managers
 - Clinic physicians who admit to the hospital
- Alert provides guidance to clinicians to intervene to prevent future readmissions



- **Note:** Alert will not fire for Women's Health or Behavioral Health physicians
