

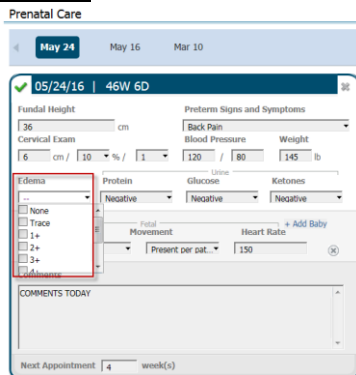

❖ Changes to Edema Options on the Pregnancy Summary Prenatal Card (Effective July 20, 2016)

Trace will be separated out from 1+ under the **Edema Generalized** options on the Prenatal Card. Options will display as **None, Trace, 1+, 2+, 3+, 4+, Dependent, Non-Pitting, Pitting, Other.**

❖ Fetalink Update (Beginning July 14, 2016)

Cerner has identified a resolution to the Fetalink slowness issues. However, there will be a slight workflow change when launching Fetalink. The user will no longer immediately see the login screen.

Use the following workflow steps when launching Fetalink:

- 1) When launching Fetalink, you will be taken directly to the Fetalink screen where you will see the census and be able to view the tracing. **Note full patient names do not immediately display. You are not logged into Fetalink yet** and will not be able to annotate or finalize a tracing until steps 2 through 4 are complete.
- 2) Click the **Sign In** button on the toolbar.
- 3) Enter your username and password.
- 4) Once you sign in, the full patient name will be visible and you will be to annotate or finalize a tracing.
