### • Suicide Prevention Forms in Spanish *Available Now!*

The Suicide Prevention forms have been updated and translated into Spanish. The forms are available on the CSM- Intranet Nursing page and can be accessed by all unit staff by clicking on "Suicide Precautions/Documentation Tool Kit" in the "Physician Orders and Tool Kits". \*\*\*\* SUICIDE PREVENTION TOOLKIT INSTRUCTIONS NEW 3/16/18\*\*\*\*

- Ad Hoc Risk Assessment complete upon admission with concern for risk
- Constant Observation Flowsheet every 15"
- Suicide / Homicide Prevention Room Safety Checklist UPDATED 7/24/17
  - Note: Signature line added
  - Complete a new form if checklist revisited (e.g. critical care, now needing additional precautions when more mobile)
- Suicide Precautions: Document "suicide precautions" in Adult Shift Documentation
- Reasons for Living Inventory (patient to complete once, review with patient, RN & family/friend, document status every 8 hrs. & ensure completion at discharge with copy to patient)
- Suicide Prevention / Crisis Intervention Worksheet (Suicide Prevention Handbook) Patient to complete, review with patient & RN document status every 8 hrs. & ensure completion at discharge with copy for patient)
- Suicide Prevention Plan (Patient to complete, review with patient, RN & family, document status every 8 hrs. & ensure completion at discharge with copy for patient)
- What Every Family Should Know (Explain to family along with Prevention Plan & Reasons For Living Upon discharge)
- Ongoing Suicide Assessment (in iView) document every 8 hrs & p.r.n.
- Suicide Ideation Plan of Care with applicable interventions & daily GDAR notes
- If patient is getting continuing care post-discharge, send copies of paper forms along with discharge paper work
