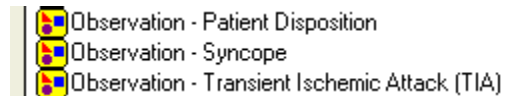

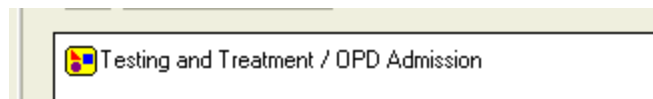
## Patient Record Committee – one- liners...

- Search by entering observation in the “Find” window




- Testing and Treatment/OPD Admission PowerPlan
