❖ **Paging Ancillary Departments – Orders Routine and Stat**

- Stress Test orders – Page Tech if after hours, weekends and holidays. This needs to be done to ensure all appropriate staff and materials (including meds) are available for the stress test.
- Pacer Clinic – Page Pacer Clinic for any pacer check orders.
- UltraSound – Page during regular hours for any Stat US orders.

More information to come in a single document that highlights all departments that require paging or a phone call during or after hours.

❖ **Urinary Catheter Orders - Nursing (starting April 1st)**

- A Urinary Catheter Insertion/Continuation PowerPlan is required for all patients with a urinary catheter
- Ordering provider placed a Urinary Catheter Insertion/Continuation PowerPlan prior to a urinary catheter being placed. At times, nursing may need to order a PowerPlan as a TORB/VORB
- Refer to full job aid located on EHR Learning Page

❖ **Urinary Catheter Orders - Providers (starting April 1st)**

- A Urinary Catheter Insertion/Continuation PowerPlan is required for all patients with a urinary catheter
- Ordering provider placed a Urinary Catheter Insertion/Continuation PowerPlan prior to a urinary catheter being placed. At times, nursing may need to order a PowerPlan as a TORB/VORB
- Refer to full job aid located on Physician Portal

❖ **Peripheral & Central Line Insertion Date**

- An insertion date field has been added to the dynamic groups for peripheral and central lines. This allows a user to view the insertion date when hovering over active lines.

❖ **Heart Failure Teachback**

- Heart Failure teachback is now included in the **Core Measures: Heart Failure Education** PowerForm.
- To eliminate confusion, Heart Failure Core Measures education section, which does NOT include necessary teachback, will be removed from IView on 4/1.

❖ Admission History Adult PowerForm Updates (starting April 2nd)

- Under “Transfusion” section, when documenting a Prior Transfusion with or without a reaction, nursing must also ask if the patient has been transfused in the last 3 months.

Box goes from grey to white when the following is selected under Transfusion History:
 Prior transfusion w/ reaction
 Prior transfusion w/o reaction

- Under “General Info” section, when documenting Patient Denies or Confirmed Negative, nursing must also ask if the patient has been pregnant in the last 3 months.

Box goes from grey to white when the following is selected under Pregnancy Status:
 Patient Denies
 Confirmed negative

Patient Record Committee Updates (one-liners)

- ❖ Heparin Full Dose Infusion PowerPlan – Daily CBC order is now pre-checked
- ❖ Cardiac Implantable Electronic Device Pre PowerPlan: (coming the week of April 1st)
 - In order to be in compliance with antibiotic SCIP issues, the start time for Vancomycin pre-procedure was edited to say “Begin on nursing unit immediately prior to departure to Cath Lab”
 - This was added to the comment section for Vancomycin pre-procedure
- ❖ The Intermediate Care Unit will be added to “admit to” inpatient orders. The location will also be incorporated in to the necessary PowerPlans as one of the default choices
- ❖ Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Post PowerPlan is available for use
