



## ❖ **LEAPT- Restricted Med PowerForm (Effective 6/30/14)**

As part of Columbia St. Mary's Antimicrobial Stewardship Program to conserve efficacy of certain narrow spectrum antibiotics (Daptomycin, Linezolid, Tigecycline and Ceftaroline), providers will be required to supply additional documentation in a Restricted Med PowerForm upon ordering.

Providers are to select the indication from the Restricted Criteria in the PowerForm. Providers may leave additional comments (such as intended duration of therapy) should they wish to. A reference text Dosing Considerations band is available for each of these medications.

## ❖ **Stroke PowerPlans (Available NOW)**

Stroke Hemorrhagic Admission, Stroke Ischemic Non-tPA Admission, and Stroke Ischemic Post tPA Therapy PowerPlans had edits to the BP parameters in the "Notify Provider" order.

## ❖ **Auto-Initiate PowerPlans (Effective after 6/26/14)**

To prevent missed orders for high risk patients, the following PowerPlans will not have the "Initiate" button and will therefore not be able to be put in a "planned" state. They will become active at the time of signature (auto-initiate):

- ED Sepsis
- Stroke tPA Alert
- ED Pneumonia
- ACS –Low Risk
- Heart Alert - STEMI/LBBB
- Stroke Alert
